Details

Paul Street Adolescent Program, in Blacktown, was established in July 2000. Previously, the service was known as the Kingsleigh Group Home. Run by Anglicare, the Paul Street Adolescent Program provides accommodation for up to 5 teenaged boys. It was intended to provide support to children who had experienced significant trauma and had higher needs, and aimed to prepare them for independent living or other permanent care. Paul Street Adolescent Program closed in August 2016.
