

Industrial School for Girls, Nudgee

1903 - 1942

Details

The Industrial School for Girls, in Nudgee, was operated by the Order of the Sisters of Mercy. It was co-located with St Vincent's Home for Children. No girls were placed there after 1942.

The Industrial School for Girls, Nudgee was established and licensed in 1903 under the *Industrial and Reformatory Schools Act* 1865 and later under the *State Children Act* 1911 on 31 December 1911.
