Details

The James Brown Memorial Trust was a sum of money bequeathed in 1892 by James Brown's wife, Jessie, to be used for benevolent purposes in his memory. The Trust was established by an Act of Parliament, *The James Brown Memorial Act 1894*. The legacy was used to establish both Kalyra Hospital and Estcourt House. The trustees of the James Brown Memorial Trust ran Estcourt House, 1894-1955, and Kalyra Hospital, 1894 -1988. The James Brown Memorial Trust was still operating in 2014.
