Details

St Anne's Maternity Home was run by the Sisters of Mercy from around 1958 in the Perth suburb of Mount Lawley. During this time St Anne's was referred to as both a Hospital and a Home, with the terms being used interchangably. Many babies were adopted from St Anne's in this period. In 1982 the Home was officially renamed St Anne's Mercy Hospital.

St Anne's Maternity Home was mentioned in the *Commonwealth Contribution to Former Forced Adoption Policies* and *Practices* Report (2012) as an institution that was involved in forced adoption.

• Inquiry into past forced adoptive policies and practices, Western Australian government (2023 - 2024)

The WA inquiry into past forced adoptive policies and practices found that institutions operated by the Sisters of Mercy (now Institute of Sisters of Mercy Australia and Papua New Guinea) engaged in pressure and coercion practices which caused unmarried mothers to agree to the adoption of their children.
