Details

The Department of Child Safety, Seniors and Disability Services was created in May 2023 when the function of youth justice was moved out of the former Department of Children, Youth Justice and Multicultural Affairs.

The Department had responsibility for providing access to historical child welfare records as well as overseeing current child safety issues.

Following an election in November 2024, the Department became the Department of Families, Seniors, Disability Services and Child Safety.
