Ten expectant mothers were evacuated from a dormitory during a fire at Hove last night.

The fire at the Kate Cocks Memorial Babies Home was confined to one room in the single storey dormitory.

However, the room and its contents were destroyed and the rest of the building suffered smoke and water damage.

Fire units from Gleneig and St. Marys attended.

Police said damage had been estimated at about \$3,000.

The fire is believed to have started when clothes left in front of a heater caught alight.

No one was injured in the blaze, which broke out about 6 p.m.
