CORPS HISTORY

INSTRUCTIONS

1. This Book is the property of the General of The Salvation Army, and will be kept by the Corps Secretary, who is responsible for its accuracy and safe custody.

2. All occurrences of a special nature affecting this Corps shall be recorded in this book from time to time. The information must be written neatly in black ink, and as plainly as possible. The Corps Secretary should make it his business to write up the entries at least once in each month, otherwise there is a danger that important events deserving of record will be overlooked.

3. As a general guide to Secretaries it should be noted that particulars of such occurrences as the following should be carefully entered:

The names of Officers, with dates of their entry and farewell.

Anniversaries—Senior and Young People's.

Special Campaigns (Spiritual and Financial), with results.

Revivals.

Notable deaths, with fuller particulars than are contained in the Register of Promotions to Glory.

Visits of prominent Staff Officers.

Exceptional town events in which The Salvation Army takes part, such as—

Hospital Sundays.

Strikes.

Distress.

Epidemics.

Minor events should not be entered here, such as, for instance, the visit of any Corps Band, or visits or events of an ordinary character.

4. The date of the occurrence to be recorded must in all cases be inserted in the left-hand margin of the page. A line should be ruled in red ink right across the page at the end of each record.

This book must at all times be open to inspection of Commanding Officers or Divisional Commanders, or any Officer appointed by the National Headquarters for that purpose.
